Questions

- Tackett: How was the last football game? Were there enough volunteers?
 - Yes, but it was the same volunteers as always. This is becoming very difficult to sustain as the band gets bigger.
 - We are going to work on getting more volunteers.
 - 8th grade interest meeting is in Feb.
- Tackett: Does the school have a budget for instrument repair?
 - Lawson: Yes, but it has to last for the entire year, so it has to be paced. Sousaphone repair costs ~\$800. Chimes cost \$3000. All schools have same budget, not based on the size of the band. Anything not covered by the school is covered by the booster organization.
 - Lawson working on a grant to replace drum line. (~\$15,000)
 - Bliss: Is corporate sponsorship a possibility?
 - Lawson: Need to check legality, booster org is 501(c)(3).
 - Tetrault is going to talk to Athletic Boosters about sponsors.
 - Bus costs come out of VHSL budget.
- Tackett: Child protection training is not required for volunteering?
 - Lawson: Correct, not a school district requirement unless you are working inside the school.
 - Free computer-based training available, like for Boy Scouts or Safe Sports.
 - This would be a bigger concern if the students were younger.
- Tackett: No volunteers needed for Jazz Band?
 - Lawson: No, small group (17 students) doesn't need additional bus with chaperones.
- Lawson: How else can we market our meetings to get more involvement?
 - Tetrault: Zoom meeting option, by invitation only?
 - Reminder sign at football games?
 - Email reminders?
