Michael Bliss / President

- Bandquet will be 6/2, 6-8pm. Will provide opportunity to vote for next year's board members, TTBP budget, and to sign up for volunteering opportunities.
- Announced food drive.

Marie Ivanco / Outreach

- Food drive for the Peninsula Food Bank will start on 5/20 and will last two weeks.

Sumie Shima / Treasurer

- Checking: \$27,285.14. Savings has \$2526.21, which includes savings for trailers. We need to set aside \$2500 for uniforms and also need to set aside money for awards.
 - CD cannot be opened online, have to go to the bank in person.
 - Booster should increase annual savings for uniforms. Anticipating needing \$45K for the band portion. Current rate of savings (\$2500/year) is insufficient.
 - Board members present voted to move \$10K from checking to a 4-month CD.

- Disney trip Information
 - Disney trip information sheet was sent out again today. Includes all information on accommodation, schedule, etc.
 - Will leave between 5 and 6am on Sunday. Students will need to pack breakfast to eat on the bus. Will stop one time on the way down for a meal. Will arrive in Disney, students will get money to spend on dinner.
 - Monday, they will have two \$50 cards to use in the park for food. Will spend the day at Hollywood studios and will have a clinic.
 - Tuesday will be at Magic Kingdom, will stay for fireworks.
 - They will also get one entry into an entertainment venue to play arcade games.
 - Sheet includes payment schedule (6/1 is the first payment. Exact cost of the bus will depend on the number of students signing up. Assistance can be provided if needed, anonymous process.
 - Note: on the volunteer interest form, there is a question about providing scholarship money for students.
 - Chaperones: the number of chaperones will hinge on number of children who join the trip.
- Tag Day
 - Will follow same approach as last year with Tag Day taking place after Fall camp. Will also do the phone tag-a-thon this year again.
 - Students will eat lunch in the band room.
 - Goal is \$20K this year: **Mr. Lawson will die his hair orange if we make the goal.**
 - Tag Day fundraising is what gives the band flexibility throughout the school year in terms of expenditures.

- Marching show
 - Props for next year are being built by Andrea and David Storch. Will be painted at the school soon.
 - T-shirt design contest is under way and designs are due by 6/1.
 - There is a chance that the band will be too big for the grass practice field. The asphalt practice section needs to be relined. Parking lot maintenance has done it in 2019-2020, a striping company has done it for free in the past (Everline coating). Will need an industrial blower to remove the silt of the old lines. If anyone has a lead, please share with Mr. Lawson.
