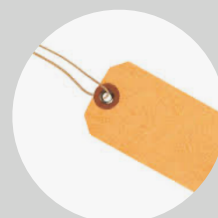

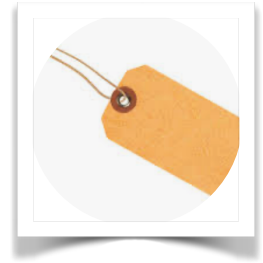
Fall Tag Day

Tag Day (Christina Calhoon):

- 12 Sept, after Fall Band Camp
- Targeting 30 parent hosts, with list finalized by 21 Aug
- Kids will choose groups after parent hosts assigned to neighborhoods
- Groups will have signs, wear show shirts to identify as band students
- Looking into more professional tag options, pricing

- New heavy-duty hangers and double-reinforced uniform bags have been purchased!
- Uniform and shoe fitting on 7 Aug, 1 - 5pm
 - Will need 3 - 4 parent volunteers to help with setup and fittings

From Our Executive Committee:

Treasurer (Sumie Shima outgoing, Jim Polick incoming):

- Checking balance: \$17,727, Savings balance: \$2,526.32
 - \$10,000 in CD opened 15 May with 3.6% annual return
- Shima to transfer bank accounts, continuity binder to Polick
- TTBP is getting close to crossing 501(c)(3) threshold of \$50,000
- Budget will be discussed at 3 Aug parent meeting

Outreach (Marie Ivanco):

- Salvation Army bell ringing has been canceled last couple of years, so plan to discontinue
- Food drive was a HUGE success this year - continue this next year

Fundraising (Kayla Money-Murray):
